TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Revised March 2008

1. Each month the draw is made by the Tournament Director and entrants are placed in flights according to their USGA handicaps. The draw also determines starting time and pairings which will be posted on the website with as much advance notice as possible.
2. GOLFERS SHOULD BE AT THE COURSE READY TO PLAY AT LEAST 30 MINUTES BEFORE START TIME AND AT THEIR DESIGNATED TEE, 10 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START TIME. PLAYERS MUST BE PRESENT AND READY TO PLAY AT DESIGNATED TIME OR BE DISQUALIFIED.
3. Measuring devices may be used only for the purpose of distance measurements. The distance information is considered public knowledge and may be shared with other players.
4. Participants in tournaments are responsible for their own cart reservations and rental costs at golf clubs, unless otherwise noted on the tournament entry form.
5. The **Official W.S.W.P.L.A. Scorecard** provided at registration must be used and completed for each tournament. Players should exchange **Official Scorecards** with someone in their playing group. **Your scorecard** must be dated, signed and attested before it is turned in. **NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE to any of the scores on any of the 18 holes after a card is signed and turned in.** (The scoring committee checking the score cards may make corrections to the sum of the scores but not to any individual hole score). Players need only to record gross score to scorecard.
6. After finishing play, a player completes and turns in her **Official Scorecard** to the Scoring Chairperson before putting clubs away, eating or leaving the course. This will assist the scoring committee to complete the posting of scores and selection of winners in a timely manner.
7. **Do not post your score to GHIN.** This is the responsibility of the Tournament Director. Scores will be adjusted by the Tournament Pairing Program on the computer and posted directly to GHIN.
8. Any entrant who wishes to scratch after the day's play; write **scratch** across the official scorecard, sign it and turn it in to the Scoring chairperson before leaving the course.
9. An entrant into W.S.W.P.L.A. tournaments must be familiar with the U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf.
10. All questions on rules should be referred to the Rules Chairperson. Participants should pick up a rules sheet at registration before start of play. All rules questions should be settled before signing or attesting the scorecard.
11. Low gross and low net of the field is paid in each tournament (except Two-Person Best Ball). During the 'regular' tournaments, winners in each flight are paid according to a pay out schedule approved by the tournament committee.
12. Refunds are at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
13. The following annual tournament awards will be given out to the winners at the annual Fall luncheon in November:
 - a. Individual Low Gross of the Field for the year
 - b. Individual Low Net of the Field for the year
 - c. Individual Holes-in-One
 - d. Individual Eagles
 - e. Perpetual trophy to the Club with the highest winnings for the tournament year
